

TRANSFER REQUESTS TO OTHER SUBSIDIZED HOUSING

If I already live in subsidized housing can I transfer to another subsidized housing location owned by the same social housing provider?

Yes. Every social housing provider has rules about how you can transfer from one unit to another. The rules will also tell you the reasons you may be allowed to transfer.

You may ask for a copy of the rules and discuss your situation with your property manager.

If I already live in subsidized housing can I transfer to another subsidized housing location owned by a different social housing provider?

Yes. You must apply to transfer at the Central Housing Registry. When you apply, you will choose the other buildings you wish to transfer to. There is no limit on the number of locations you may choose.

Your name will be added as an applicant to the central waiting list on the date you applied to transfer to other locations you choose, unless you are an *overhoused* household.

If you are overhoused, you will be added to the central waiting list using the date you originally applied for subsidized housing.
