



### Can my name be removed from the waiting list for subsidized housing?

Yes.

Generally, you may be taken off the waiting list for following reasons.

- If you ask to be taken off the list
- If you are asked to supply information by a certain date and you do not supply the information by that date
- If you do not qualify for subsidized housing any more. For example, if your income goes over the limit for subsidized housing.
- If you accept an offer for subsidized housing
- If you refuse three offers of subsidized housing from locations that you chose.

### Special Needs Applicants

If you are a special needs applicant, you may refuse as many offers for subsidized housing as you wish without being taken off the waiting list.

### Appeals

If your name is taken off the waiting list you may appeal. Feel free to ask the staff of the Central Housing Registry how to appeal if you are taken off the list.
